- Based on these environmental aspects and impacts, goals and objectives are established along with processes necessary to deliver results/environmental management programmes, that are consistent with the environmental policy.
- Implement the processes against environmental policy, objectives, targets, legal and other requirements, reporting of the results and taking action to continually improve performance of EMS.
