

BIO HAZARDS – Control, Mitigation, and Protection

The COVID-19 pandemic has highlighted the potentially devastating impact of biological hazards on the global workforce. In response, the International Labour Conference will be held in Geneva in June 2024 to discuss biological hazard controls, mitigation, and protection, aiming to establish a comprehensive legal framework. Member countries of the International Labour Organization (ILO) will be expected to develop national policies for preventing and protecting workers against biological hazards, aligning these policies with international standards. A total of 187 countries are expected to participate, with the goal of creating common legislation to govern occupational health and safety and improve working conditions worldwide.





The ILO emphasizes that workers in environments such as hospitals, laboratories, cattle farms and production factories, grain silos, sewage maintenance facilities, waste collection and disposal, farming, agriculture, and related activities may be exposed to biological hazards. These hazards include bacteria, viruses, parasites, fungi, prions, DNA materials, bodily fluids, microorganisms, and their associated allergens and toxins. Such exposure can lead to diseases like Influenza, COVID-19, and plague, as well as non-communicable diseases such as allergies. According to ILO studies, in 2021, work exposure to contagious and non-contagious biological risks resulted in 550,000 fatalities, accounting for 9.8% of all work-related deaths and representing 0.50% of the global GDP, equivalent to US\$ 545 billion.

The Central Pollution Control Board, under the Ministry of Environment and Forests, is responsible for controlling, protecting, and mitigating biological hazards through city Municipal Corporations and other government authorities. Organizations must also ensure the health and safety of workers exposed to various industries and activities. The effective implementation of international standards such as ISO 14001 (Environmental Management System) and ISO 45001 (Occupational Health and Safety) will help safeguard workers' occupational health and safety against physical, chemical, and biological hazards.

ESG criteria, carbon credits, and carbon footprint measurement are integral to sustainable business practices, offering frameworks for companies to manage environmental impacts, enhance transparency, and contribute to global climate goals.

Topic: Powering Progress, Preserving Nature: The Tarapur Case

Tarapur Atomic Power Station is located about 140 km North of Mumbai in Palghar district of Maharashtra. This Power Station is situated on the sea shore and comprises of four units. Initially, unit 1&2 were established in 1969 with an initial generating capacity of 210 Mwe each. The cooling water requirement is drawn from the sea through an intake channel and the warm water from the condensers is discharged back into the sea through an outfall channel. Selection of location of

cooling water Intake and Outfall is important at the design stage of any power plant

Outcome and Benefits

- · The intake and outfall structures were designed in such a way that, no warm water reticulation takes place while both the power stations are operating to their full capacity, simultaneously.
- · The Power Stations are getting their desired quantum of Cooling water and working satisfactorily.
